SOUTH DARFUR

Displacement due to Conflict

▶ Background

More than 2,000 households reported to be displaced in Manwashi, Wihda, Mershing and Otach camps in Mershing and Nyala Localities, South Darfur as a result of the conflict between the government and SLA armed forces in East Jebel Marra during the period January – June 2016 were verified by NCA, RDN and IOM during the reporting period. ES/NFI assistance was provided to 1,924 verified households.

Displacement due to Conflict

▶ Background

Some 1,200 households reported to be displaced in Golo, Rokoro, Toor and Gildo in Jebel Marra locality as a result of the conflict between the government and SLA armed forces in Jebel Marra during the period Jan- June 2016 were assessed by partner NCA, and ES/NFI assistance provided to 1000 verified Households.
