

NFI COMMON PIPELINE MONTHLY REPORT

Darfur Distributions (1-31 September 2016)

During the reporting period, 3,498 households in South, West and East Darfur were provided with ES/NFI items from the NFI Common Pipeline through implementing partners. A breakdown of distributions can be seen in the tables below.

Displacement due to Conflict: n/a

Displacement due to Disaster: heavy rain

► Background

Some 138 households in Khairban, ZamZam Camp, Kebkabiya town, and Kargaweyat in El Fashir, Kutum, Kebkabiya and Dar Elsalam localities respectively were reported to have been displaced due to the destruction of their shelters by heavy rain. ES/NFI assistance was provided to 63 households following verification.

Returnees

► Background

An interagency mission was conducted in Umbaro Locality early August by partners SAG, IOM and NOHS, with the participation of UNHCR ESNFI project staff to verify some 1,650 reported returnees. The mission verified 1,500 returnees in need of ES/NFIS, which were provided from the common pipeline and distributed by SAG.

Displacement due to Disaster: floods

► Background

Over 1,200 households in Otash and Al Serif IDP Camps in Nyala locality, South Darfur, were reported to have been displaced due to the destruction of their shelters by floods. ES/NFI assistance was provided to 992 households following verification by NCA and IIRO.

WEST DARFUR

Displacement due to Conflict

► Background

Around 400 households were reported to be displaced in Um Tajouk Village, Krenik Locality, due to the armed tribal clashes in Krenik that occurred early August. An inter-agency mission comprising World Relief, ADRA, UNHCR ESNFI Project and HAC was conducted in Krenik locality to assess the needs of the displaced caseloads. Verified 322 households received NFIs from the common pipeline by Partner World Relief.

More than 650 households in Nertiti, in Central Darfur were reported to have been displaced due to the destruction of their shelters by heavy rain. ES/NFI assistance from the NFI Common Pipeline was provided to 621 households following verification.

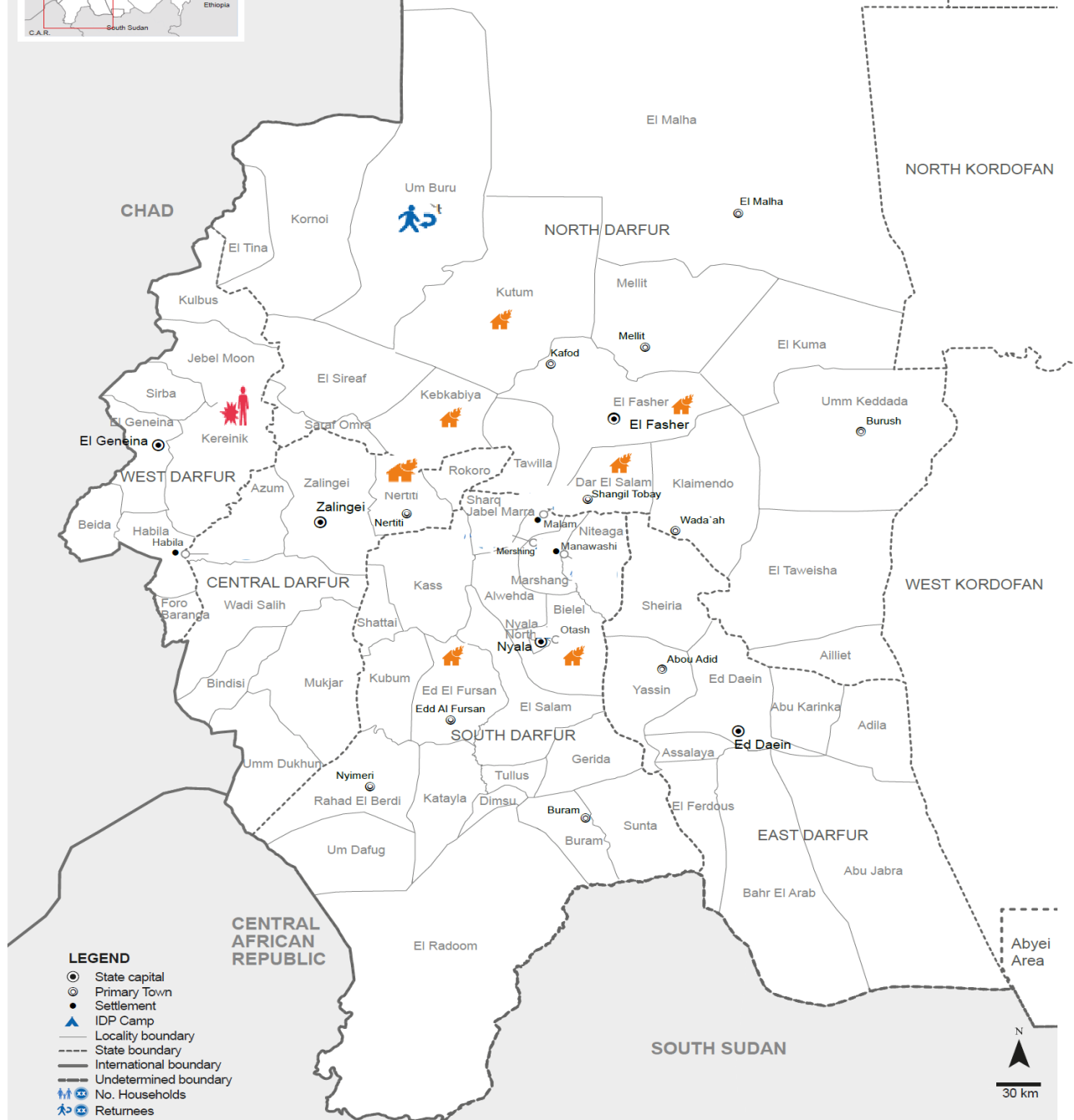
