- > IOM has reported that they have funded stock of local shelter materials and plastic sheeting to be distributed to 420 HHs identified as very poor families through IOM verification

- Otash camp RDN has reported 2 HHs been affected by fire incident in Otash IDPs camp on 2/2/2016, relatively they assessed and verified the living condition of affected population and confirmed their vulnerability accompanied with report/list and NFIs request for urgent response.
- In response to the Humanitarian Aid Commission's request and AHCT to assess the humanitarian situation of the affected populations (575 households) who displaced from Obeid village/ Belil locality to Sheigei & Kabgay villages in Nitega locality over the conflict between farmers and pastoralist in12 December 2015,UNHCR/ESNFIs sector has participated with UNHCR, OCHA, WFP, UNICEF, UNFPA, WHO, IOM & WVI, 575 HHs new arrivals live at open place and under trees with lack of all basic service and water sources (10-12 km ) identified, and accordingly response plans placed jointly with other sectors in soonest.
- **Sakali camp** NCA jointly with Alhusna national organization and HAC have conducted need based assessment on 8<sup>th</sup> of current month in Sakali IDPs camp over fire incident occurred by misused, 8 HHs were captured massively destroyed in shelters and assets and they have been recommended to be supported with emergency NFIs assistance from CHP.

### **Update of distributions by implementing partners:**

**NCA** has completed NFIs distribution to 184 HHs IDPs identified as most vulnerable in Sakali camp, 31 HHs fire affected in Al-mustagbal camp in Nyala locality and 121 HHs fire destroyed in Sarman Jabou return village in Mershing locality.

Implementing partners were reminded to submitted all required documents such as distribution reports, photos, beneficiary list hard /soft copy to sector after completion of distribution in regular manner for purpose of proper documentation.

### **Emergency Shelter Updates:**

206 HHs 2014 arrivals in Kossa gathering area have received emergency shelter materials composed with plastic sheeting dispatched form IOM's own stock purchased for the purpose.

UPO shared trainings plan targeting environment friend shelter committees100 in Bul bul Tembisco/ Alsalam locality and 100 in Batey/Nitega locality, scheduled in the period 14-24<sup>th</sup>
